Forecast Confidence

Timing



The greatest coverage of storms is expected this evening after 5-6pm. Greatest uncertainty is whether or not a couple storms can develop earlier in the afternoon.

Location



While the risk for severe storms is area wide today, the areas at greatest risk for severe hazards will be across south central and southeast KS.

Hazards



Damaging winds of 60-70 mph will be the main hazard this evening. However, there's a large hail and isolated tornado risk (southern KS) with isolated storms that develop early.

Key Messages

- Severe storms possible late afternoon through tonight.
- Southern KS has the greatest chance of seeing severe storms.



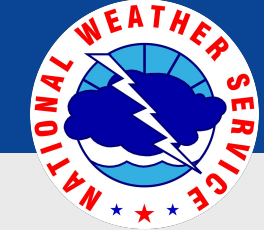

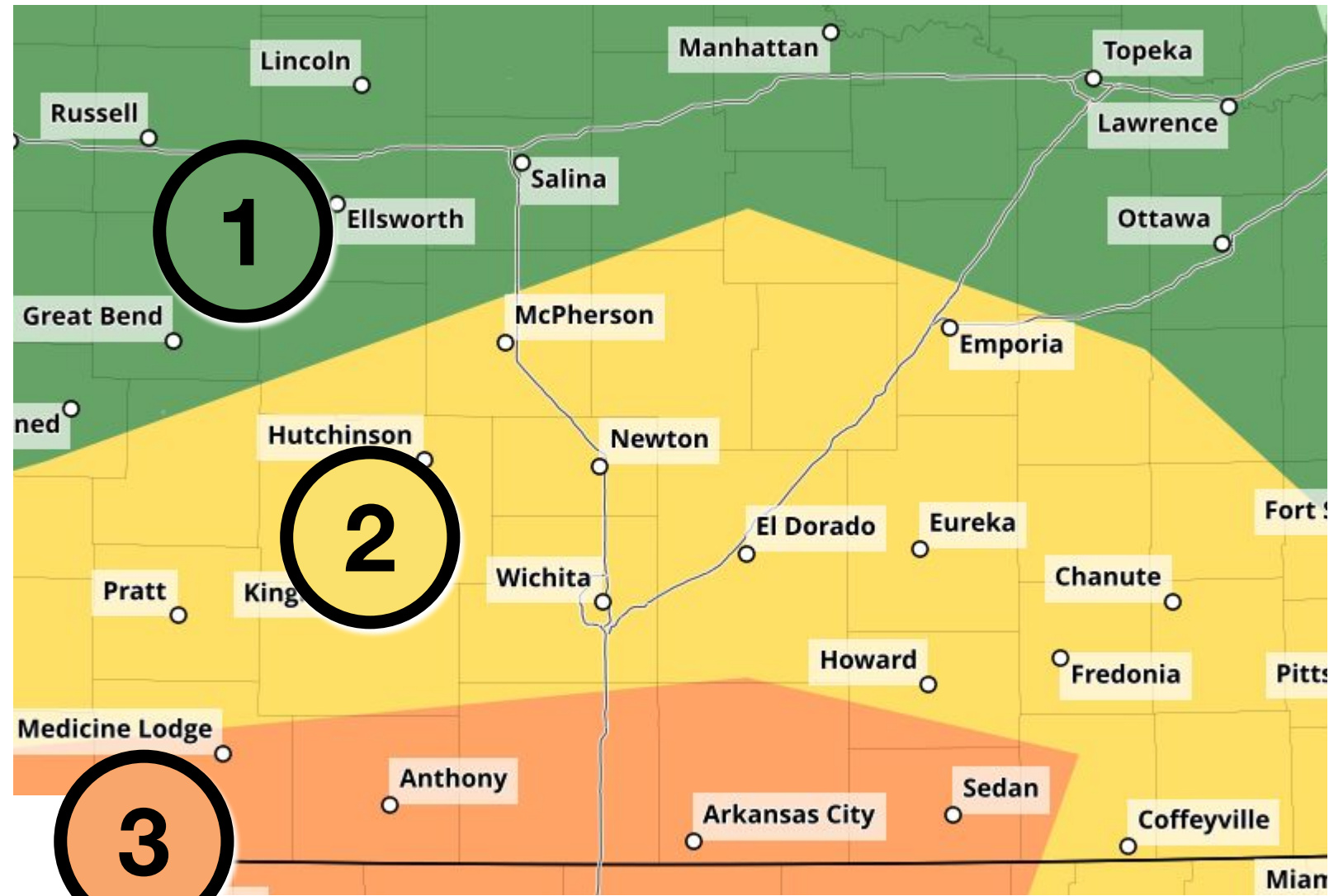

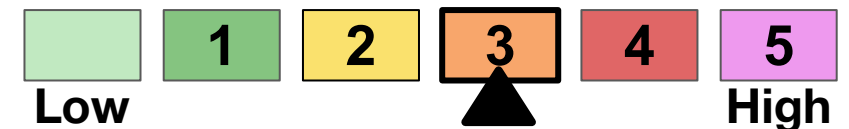

A Severe Thunderstorm Watch is issued when **a severe thunderstorm is possible**.

Stay tuned to forecast updates, monitor sky conditions, and know where to take shelter.
