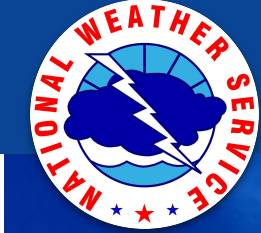

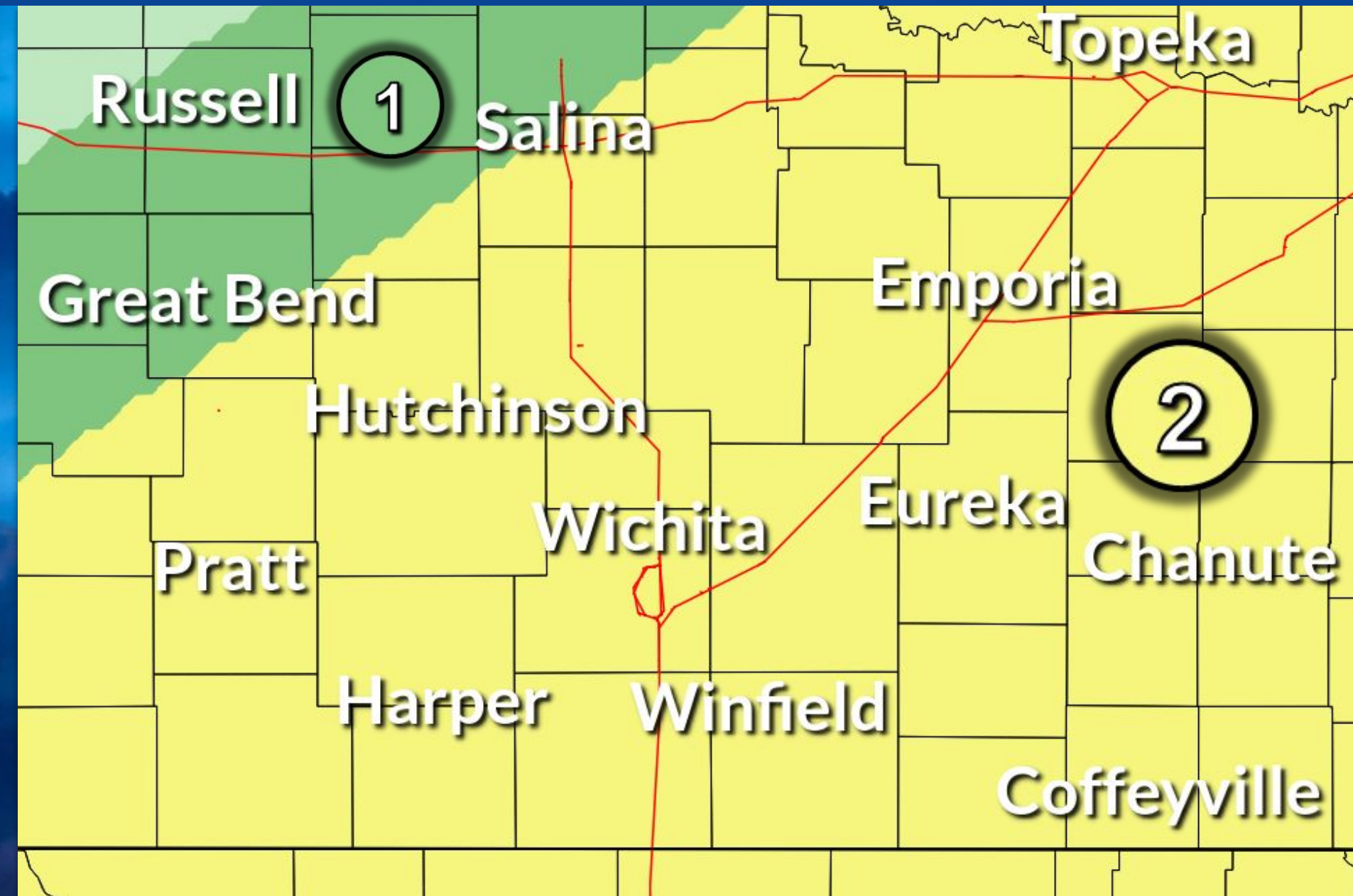


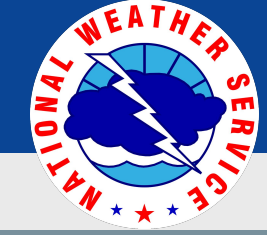
TIMING

Storms will be likely along and north of a cold front with some uncertainty how far south the front will make it.

Confidence is starting to increase that storms will wait until after 4 pm to develop with the more widespread activity after 7 pm

Large hail up to golf ball size looks to be the main threat with some downburst winds also possible. However, if storms start to cluster, the hail threat would be reduced some.

A Severe Thunderstorm Watch is issued when **a severe thunderstorm is possible.**

Stay tuned to forecast updates, monitor sky conditions, and know where to take shelter.
